Congratulations for being chosen to be a part of Encore! I am very excited about this group of singers, and I have high expectations for what you will accomplish. Below you will find some expectations that I have for members of this group, as well as some important information that you need to be aware of.

Rehearsals

[~]We will rehearse every Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday after school from 3:20-4:00.

~All members of Encore are expected to be at every practice unless you are home sick from school. If you are well enough to make it to school, you need to be at practice.

~Please try to avoid scheduling appointments during the time we practice.

[~]Those of you in other sports and activities; be proactive in talking with your coaches and advisors about your commitment to Encore. If they give you a hard time about being a little late a couple times a week, let me know and I will contact them and discuss this with them.

~We WILL NOT practice on early-out days.

Performances

~You will perform at a couple of the regular high school choir concerts.

~You will also be performing in the community, especially around Christmas. I will let you know about specific dates and locations as soon as I find out about them.

~You will help plan, organize, and perform in a school wide talent show in April.

Expectations
