Concert Dates

Choir is a performance-based class, and every student in choir is required to attend every performance. If you foresee an excused conflict with a concert, you MUST contact Mr. Aulie or Mrs. Swanson as soon as possible, and we will assign an alternate method of making up these points. In case of conflict with a sport or activity, district policy is that students will attend the concert. Excused absences must be made up within one week of the concert or upon return to school. If the assignment is not completed or if the absence is unexcused, this will result in a grade reduction of one letter grade.

Grading Policy

Although we spend significant time talking about and looking forward to our three concerts, the most important aspect of being in this class is the effort contributed to our daily rehearsals. Our choirs are only successful when every member is trying to positively contribute to the success of these rehearsals. The most significant part of a student's grade in choir involves their level of participation on a daily basis. All choir students will be assessed on the two areas noted below:

Participation- This includes daily participation in classroom activities and participation in our concerts. Students' participation are assessed daily and updated weekly in Skyward. Participation grades involve posture, voice-building, socialization, taking care of folder/music, and participation in rehearsal.

Sight-Reading/Music Fundamentals Assessments- Choir students will take sight reading and music fundamental quizzes and tests. These evaluations will be based on the skills learned during our daily rehearsals. Some of these will be written exams and some will be performance based.

Daily Routines

Tardiness: All students are expected to get their music folder and be in their seats by the time the bell rings. Students who do not do this will be marked tardy.

Hall Passes: Students should take care of bathroom and locker needs prior to class starting. No hall passes will be given during class.

Folders: Each student will be assigned a folder with choir music. The folder and music in it are the responsibility of the student.

Food and Drink: We highly encourage our students to drink a lot of water! Besides water, no other food or beverages are permitted in class, and this includes GUM!!!
